




PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITIES

Also, all accepted papers for ICOAF-2025 will be published in the conference **proceedings with an associated ISBN**.

All accepted papers must be presented at the conference. Failure to present the accepted paper will result in its withdrawal from the conference proceedings.

Only original papers will be considered. The manuscripts must not be previously published or accepted for publication elsewhere.

All headings should have a minimum of three text lines after them before a page or column break. Ensure the text area is not blank except for the last page. [Ctrl + Shift + N]

4. Figures [Alt+7]




Fig. 1. (a) first picture; (b) second picture. [Alt+B]
